**Resolution to Acknowledge and Approve
Grant Contract Agreement with State of Minnesota**

WHEREAS, a grant application was prepared for and submitted by the Park and Trails Committee on behalf of the City of Oronoco to the State of Minnesota, acting through its Department of Natural Resources, Division of Forestry; and

WHEREAS, a grant award was made as a result of the application as evidenced by a State of Minnesota Grant Contract Agreement between the State of Minnesota, acting through its Department of Natural Resources, Division of Forestry (STATE) and the City of Oronoco (GRANTEE);

WHEREAS, a copy of the Grant Contract Agreement is attached hereto and made an integral part of this resolution and includes, in part, the following specifics:


- a) Effective date of April 15, 2022 and an expiration date of on or before June 30, 2025;
- b) Grantee's commitment to perform the duties specified in Exhibit A, Exhibit B, and Exhibit C;
- c) The total project cost is \$15,446, with no matching requirement for the grant. However, the Grantee has opted to provide a match and therefore agrees and certifies a match of at least \$5,990 of this project cost will be met by the City of Oronoco;
- d) Grantor's total compensation under the grant agreement will not exceed \$9,456.00;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Oronoco City Council adopts this resolution:

- 1. acknowledging the grant application's submittal;
- 2. acceptance of the grant award from the State of Minnesota;
- 3. approval of the Grant Contract Agreement with the State of Minnesota; and
- 4. commitment to the cost-sharing and performance defined in the grant contract agreement.


AND BE IT FUTHER RESOLVED that the City Administrator or her designee is authorized to take steps necessary for the implementation of this Resolution.
