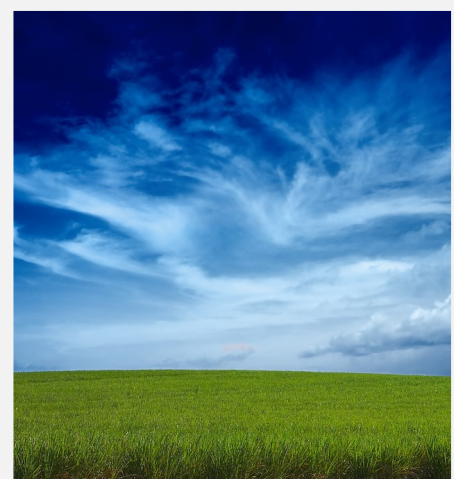

Annexation**

This is a general guide to help understand the annexation process

Q: How much does it cost?

A: 4% of the current assessed value.

Q: What is the process of an annexation?

A: The process is as follows:

- First you will need to fill out the application. The application is on the City Website at www.oronoco.com or at City Hall.
- Next you will provide the application, survey, legal description of the property & Map, and General Development Plan to the

- Once all the required information is handed in, the City Clerk will then notify the City Council and Oronoco Township.
- The City Council will set the public hearing at their next regular council meeting. Council meets the third Tuesday of the month at 6:30 pm.
- You will want to be present for the meeting in case City Council has any further questions.
- At that time City Council will review the annexation and they will Approve or Deny the Annexation. If the annexation is approved, the City Clerk will notify all parties of the approved annexation, such as Oronoco Township, Olmsted County, and the MN Office of Administrative Hearings.

Q: Can I appeal the finding of fact if it is denied?

A: Yes. Contact City Hall to be put on the agenda for the next meeting. That will be the only appeal you will receive.

Please remember that the more information you have for the annexation, the better City Council will be able to make an informed decision.
