- Reminder to fill out run report for every call. Front passenger should delegate/manage this task.
- Oronoco Estates is now Oakwood Meadows.
- Use IAR and google maps as a guide. Some of our more rural areas are not always accurate.
- Reminder to check that radios are back to FIRE 1, turned off, and place on charging stations after every call.
- Please familiarize yourself with the layout of all four bags and where to find supplies.
