

**A RESOLUTION  
TO COMBINE POLLING PLACES BETWEEN  
THE CITY OF ORONOCO AND ORONOCO TOWNSHIP**

City of Oronoco Resolution 2020 - 3 Dated 2-18-2020

Oronoco Township Resolution 2020-01 Dated Feb 3, 2020

Be it Resolved, that the City of Oronoco and Oronoco Township agree to combine polling places under these conditions:

1. The cost per precinct will be determined by the percent of registered voters in each precinct to the total number of registered voters. This percent will be reconsidered before the first election in each presidential election year.
2. Oronoco Township will pay election expenses and invoice the City of Oronoco for their share of expenses. Expenses will include election judge wages and food and refreshments for election judges. The City of Oronoco agrees to pay Oronoco Township the invoiced amount.
3. The cost of an election servicing only one of the precincts will be bore by the precinct requiring the election.
4. This agreement will begin with the March 3, 2020 Presidential Nominating Election and continue until modified or voided as defined below.
5. Precincts remain unchanged. Each precinct must independently report election results to authorities as Minnesota law requires. Each precinct must do the required publications and postings for their precinct, as well as any other pre- or post-election activities required by law.
6. Oronoco Township will communicate with election judges from both precincts, do scheduling and verify election judges have completed required training.
7. This agreement can be changed by mutual written agreement.
8. This agreement can be voided by one party giving the other written notice at least 120 days (or as Minnesota Statutes require) before a scheduled election.
