

Resolution 2017-11

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ORONOCO, MINNESOTA, IN SUPPORT OF A PROPOSED CAPITAL PROJECT TO CONSTRUCT WASTEWATER COLLECTION AND TREATMENT FACILITIES TO SERVE THE RESIDENTS OF THE CITY OF ORONOCO, MINNESOTA.

WHEREAS, the City of Oronoco, Minnesota ("the City") presently does not have any publically owned facilities that collect and treat wastewater generated within the boundaries of the City by residential, commercial and industrial uses; and,

WHEREAS, the City has commissioned the preparation of plans to construct publically owned facilities ("the project") that would collect and treat wastewater generated within the boundaries of the City by residential, commercial and industrial uses; and,

WHEREAS, the City presently lacks the financial resources to fund the construction of the project as planned; and,

WHEREAS, the provisions of *Minnesota Statutes* § 16A.86 provide a mechanism for the State of Minnesota in certain instances to financially assist a political subdivision in constructing a capital improvement project; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City recognizes that the health and welfare of the inhabitants of the City and the surrounding geographic area would be protected and enhanced if the project can be constructed and completed in a timely fashion.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Oronoco, Minnesota, that the City Council supports construction of the project and authorizes and directs the appropriate officers and employees of the City to apply to the Commissioner of the Minnesota Office of Management and Budget for financial assistance, pursuant to the provisions of *Minnesota Statutes* § 16A.86, to assist in the City in funding the project
